Macon County Board Resolution Repealing Resolution No. G-4476-04-16 Regarding an Increase in Probation Services Fees

Mr. Berter explained that at the time this resolution was brought to the table they wanted to increase Probation fees to \$35. After looking at the Statute, it was discovered that we cannot just increase it to \$35. It is an Administrative Sliding Scale Fee and it goes from \$0 to \$50. After discussing this with the Chief Judge, he also has to create an Administrative Order and at this time, they are unwilling to do that because it is felt that if they did this, they would actually lose more money.

Macon County Board Resolution Approving an Agreement for Macon County Sheriff's Part Time Police Services for the Village of Long Creek, Illinois

Lt. Butts explained that off duty deputies work their off hours to supply police services for the Village of Long Creek. These deputies, at the time, are considered employees of the Village. They fall under their insurance. They are paid by the Village and the vehicle they drive is a Village vehicle that all gas, oil, maintenance expenses are the Village's responsibility. The contract that goes along with the resolution is signed by the Mayor of Long Creek, County Board Chairman and the Sheriff.

Mr. Oliver asked if the coverage would be for 24 hour coverage. Lt. Butts said it is not. They budget so many hours a week for police services for the Village. There is a schedule that is desired and officers sign up for hours based on their days off and availability. They prefer weekends, some night shifts and some day shifts especially when school is in session.

Mr. Dunn made a motion to approve forwarding the resolution to the Finance Committee with recommendation for approval, seconded by Mr. Oliver and the motion carried 5-0.
