

**MACON COUNTY BOARD
RESOLUTION ADOPTING CERTAIN
CODES BY REFERENCE FOR USE BY
THE PLANNING AND ZONING
DEPARTMENT**

Resolution No. G-5043-09-19

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this board that the Macon County code of ordinances incorporate certain regulations and codes by reference so as to permit the County to enforce such regulations and codes as though such regulations and codes were originally adopted by this board; and

WHEREAS, it is more efficient for the County to incorporate certain regulations and codes that are drafted and promulgated by external entities than for the County to attempt to create original regulations and codes governing the many areas that the County is called upon to oversee; and

WHEREAS, the incorporation of certain regulations and codes by reference shall also serve to allow the County to have up to date regulations and codes as such external entities make such updates from time to time.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Macon County Board, assembled in regular meeting at Decatur that, pursuant to section 5-6002 of the Counties Code (55 ILCS 5/5-6002), the regulations and codes set forth in the attached exhibit a are adopted by reference and incorporated into the Macon County Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Macon County planning and zoning department shall file no less than three copies of each such code that is incorporated or adopted by reference with the Macon County Clerk not later than September 30, 2019.
