Title XI: Business Regulations

Chapter 95: Home Kitchen Operation

Section 95.01 Home Kitchen Operations Authorized

Home kitchen operations are authorized within the unincorporated parts of the County, subject to the provisions of Section 3.6 of the Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act (410 ILCS 625/3.6).
