WHEREAS a petition filed by Brett Thompson requesting a Special Use Permit for the installation of a certified kitchen for the production of pepper sauces, jellies and salsas for potential market sale in (A-1) Agricultural Zoning. This property legally described as:

Part of the North Half (N1/2) of Section 25, Township 17 North, Range 3 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Macon County, Illinois, described as beginning at the Northeast corner of said Section 25, running thence S 0 degrees 20' 36" W for 1334.25 feet; thence S 89 degrees 24' 05" W for 1910.70 feet; thence N 0 degrees 00' 00" E for 20.00 feet; thence N 89 degrees 24' 05" E for 1509.06 feet; thence N 0 degrees 34' 36" W for 1321.85 feet; thence S 89 degrees 55' 03" E for 422.90 feet to the point of beginning, containing 13.04 acres, more or less, situated in the County of Macon, State of Illinois.

WHEREAS, at the required public hearing on May 3, 2017 your Zoning Board of Appeals heard the testimony presented and voted to recommend approval to the County Board the petition be granted subject to the stipulations as set forth below.

1. This Special Use Permit constitutes a license issued to the named Petitioners only. This special use permit is not property nor does it convey any property right. This special use permit is, therefore, not assignable or transferable.
2. Employees shall be family members only.
3. Advertising sign regulations on the subject property shall comply with Macon County Zoning Ordinance.
4. Building permits shall be obtained as required.
5. An approved private sewage disposal system specifically for the commercial kitchen permitted and installed. This system must be installed prior to the opening inspection of the commercial kitchen

6. Prior to the opening inspection of the commercial kitchen, all private water systems will need to be properly constructed, and tested yearly, to ensure the supply is potable.
7. An approved plan review of the commercial kitchen will be required prior to any construction commencing.
8. Contact Illinois Department of Public Health regarding a wholesale license, and meet those requirements.
9. Said property and all operations shall remain subject to all other applicable local, county, state, and federal regulations. Failure to do so will result in revocation of this special use permit and it will be effective immediately.
10. Hours of operation for the business is 8:00 a.m. to 11 p.m. for 7 days a week.
11. This special use permit shall be for a 3 year period beginning June 8, 2017 and ending June 11, 2020.

INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HILL'S PET NUTRITION SALES, INC.**

WHEREAS, the Macon County Animal Control and Care Center (MCAC) has a large demand and obligation for feeding their shelter pets; and

WHEREAS, the MCAC has a great opportunity to enter into an agreement with Hill's Pet Nutrition Sales, Inc. to provide great quality In-Shelter pet food for all their shelter pets; and

WHEREAS, Hill's shall provide and/or make available In-Shelter food at the list price minus any discount as specific to 20 and 35 lbs. bags discounted to 74% and 40 lbs. bags discounted to 56%; and

WHEREAS, the agreement shall grant the shelter a non-exclusive, limited, non-transferable, revocable, non-royalty bearing license to use Hill's trademark, logos and other intellectual property as may be required by the shelter to fulfill its promotional activities pursuant to this agreement; and

WHEREAS, the MCAC agrees to maintain its credentials and standards of care for their shelter pets at all times during this agreement; and

WHEREAS, the purchases of the In-Shelter food will be used exclusively for feeding In-Shelter cats and dogs being cared for the MCAC; and

WHEREAS, the MCAC agrees to make good faith efforts to ensure that all shelter employees and volunteers involved with pet adoptions process are well trained to educate pet adopters about Hill's brands and products and other instruction material provided by Hill's from "time to time"; and

WHEREAS, the MCAC agrees to actively and exclusively display and communicate Hill's Food, Shelter & Love partnership. Not promoting, displaying, distributing, endorsing, or feeding any competitive brands and/or product pet foods: With the exception, that the MCAC may redistribute other brands of donated pet foods products so long as such redistribution does not constitute direct or implied endorsement of such donated product; and

WHEREAS; the MCAC, by entering into this agreement, believes that, a large cost savings will be the direct result if the MCAC was to enter into this proposed agreement with Hill's Pet Nutrition Sales Inc. in their future pet food needs for shelter pet dogs and cats; and

**Macon County Board Ordinance
Approving Wages of Laborers, Mechanics
& Workers Employed in Any Public Works
by The State, County, City or Any Public Body
or Any Political Subdivisions or by Anyone
Under Contract for Public Works**

ORDINANCE NO. O-127-06-17

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted the Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the County of Macon annually investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of the County of Macon employed in performing construction of public works, for said County of Macon; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Labor has not updated its prevailing rates since 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Macon County Board, assembled in regular meeting on the 8th day of June, 2017, at Decatur, that Title III, Chapter 33.01 of the Macon County Code is amended as follows:

§ 33.01 COMPENSATION; WAGES.

(A) To the extent and as required The Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/1 et seq., as amended; (hereinafter the "Act"), the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics, and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of this county is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of labor of the state as of June 2015, incorporated herein by reference. As required by the Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of this state shall supersede the Department's June 2015 determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the county. The definition of any terms appearing in this section which are also used in the aforesaid Act shall be the same as in the Act.

(B) Nothing herein contained shall be constructed to apply the general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the county to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

(C) The county shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the County Clerk this determination or any revisions of the prevailing rate of wage. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.

(D) The county shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of worker whose wages will be affected by those rates.

(E) The county shall promptly file a certified copy of this section with both the Secretary of State Index Division and the Department of Labor of the state.

(F) The county shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a copy of this section, and the publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective upon the adoption thereof.

Explanations

MACON COUNTY

IRON WORKERS (WEST) - West of a straight line just east of Route 51 to the southeast corner where Shelby, Macon and Moultrie counties meet.

The following list is considered as those days for which holiday rates of wages for work performed apply: New Years Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and Veterans Day in some classifications/counties. Generally, any of these holidays which fall on a Sunday is celebrated on the following Monday. This then makes work performed on that Monday payable at the appropriate overtime rate for holiday pay. Common practice in a given local may alter certain days of celebration. If in doubt, please check with IDOL.

Oil and chip resealing (O&C) means the application of road oils and liquid asphalt to coat an existing road surface, followed by application of aggregate chips or gravel to coated surface, and subsequent rolling of material to seal the surface.

EXPLANATION OF CLASSES

ASBESTOS - GENERAL - removal of asbestos material/mold and hazardous

materials from any place in a building, including mechanical systems where those mechanical systems are to be removed. This includes the removal of asbestos materials/mold and hazardous materials from ductwork or pipes in a building when the building is to be demolished at the time or at some close future date.

ASBESTOS - MECHANICAL - removal of asbestos material from mechanical systems, such as pipes, ducts, and boilers, where the mechanical systems are to remain.

CERAMIC TILE FINISHER, MARBLE FINISHER, TERRAZZO FINISHER

Assisting, helping or supporting the tile, marble and terrazzo mechanic by performing their historic and traditional work assignments required to complete the proper installation of the work covered by said crafts. The term "Ceramic" is used for naming the classification only and is in no way a limitation of the product handled. Ceramic takes into consideration most hard tiles.

ELECTRONIC SYSTEMS TECHNICIAN

Installation, service and maintenance of low-voltage systems which

utilizes the transmission and/or transference of voice, sound, vision, or digital for commercial, education, security and entertainment purposes for the following: TV monitoring and surveillance, background/foreground music, intercom and telephone interconnect, field programming, inventory control systems, microwave transmission, multi-media, multiplex, radio page, school, intercom and sound burglar alarms and low voltage master clock systems.

Excluded from this classification are energy management systems, life safety systems, supervisory controls and data acquisition systems not intrinsic with the above listed systems, fire alarm systems, nurse call systems and raceways exceeding fifteen feet in length.

SURVEY WORKER - Operated survey equipment including data collectors, G.P.S. and robotic instruments, as well as conventional levels and transits.

TRUCK DRIVER - BUILDING, HEAVY AND HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION

Class 1. Drivers on 2 axle trucks hauling less than 9 ton. Air compressor and welding machines and brooms, including those pulled by separate units, truck driver helpers, warehouse employees, mechanic

helpers, greasers and tiremen, pickup trucks when hauling materials, tools, or workers to and from and on-the-job site, and fork lifts up to 6,000 lb. capacity.

Class 2. Two or three axle trucks hauling more than 9 ton but hauling less than 16 ton. A-frame winch trucks, hydrolift trucks, vector trucks or similar equipment when used for transportation purposes. Fork lifts over 6,000 lb. capacity, winch trucks, four axle combination units, and ticket writers.

Class 3. Two, three or four axle trucks hauling 16 ton or more. Drivers on water pulls, articulated dump trucks, mechanics and working forepersons, and dispatchers. Five axle or more combination units.

Class 4. Low Boy and Oil Distributors.

Class 5. Drivers who require special protective clothing while employed on hazardous waste work.

TRUCK DRIVER - OIL AND CHIP RESEALING ONLY.

This shall encompass laborers, workers and mechanics who drive contractor or subcontractor owned, leased, or hired pickup, dump, service, or oil distributor trucks. The work includes transporting materials and equipment (including but not limited to, oils, aggregate supplies, parts, machinery and tools) to or from the job site; distributing oil or liquid asphalt and aggregate; stock piling material when in connection with the actual oil and chip contract. The Truck Driver (Oil & Chip Resealing) wage classification does not include supplier delivered materials.

OPERATING ENGINEER - OIL AND CHIP RESEALING ONLY.

This shall encompass the operation of all motorized heavy equipment used in oil and chip resealing, including but not limited to operating self-propelled chip spreaders, and all types of rollers (both hard and rubber tired); and other duties pertaining to the operation or maintenance of heavy equipment related to oil & chip resealing.

Other Classifications of Work:

For definitions of classifications not otherwise set out, the Department generally has on file such definitions which are available.

If a task to be performed is not subject to one of the

classifications of pay set out, the Department will upon being contacted state which neighboring county has such a classification and provide such rate, such rate being deemed to exist by reference in this document. If no neighboring county rate applies to the task, the Department shall undertake a special determination, such special determination being then deemed to have existed under this determination. If a project requires these, or any classification not listed, please contact IDOL at 217-782-1710 for wage rates or clarifications.

LANDSCAPING

Landscaping work falls under the existing classifications for laborer, operating engineer and truck driver. The work performed by landscape plantsman and landscape laborer is covered by the existing classification of laborer. The work performed by landscape operators (regardless of equipment used or its size) is covered by the classifications of operating engineer. The work performed by landscape truck drivers (regardless of size of truck driven) is covered by the classifications of truck driver.

THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH, That the Grantors **Beulah Carara** of the County of **Macon** and State of **Illinois**, and **Edythe Williams & Kent Williams** of the County of **DeKalb** and State of **Georgia** for and in consideration of the sum of **Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)** in hand paid by the County of **Macon**, State of **Illinois** acting by and through it's County Highway Department, or on it's behalf, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the benefits resulting from the maintenance of the public highway, herein referred to, do, by these presents, hereby grant, convey and dedicate to the People of the County of **Macon**, State of **Illinois**, for the purpose of a public highway, a tract of land situated in the County of **Macon** and State of **Illinois**, and described as follows:

A part of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 27, Township 18 North, Range 1 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Macon County, Illinois, more particularly described as follows;

Commencing at a mag nail found over an iron pin at the Southeast Corner of said Section 27; thence North 0 degrees 20 minutes 29 seconds East a distance of 660.35 feet, along the east line of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 27, to the Point of Beginning; thence North 89 degrees 54 minutes 04 seconds West a distance of 33.49 feet to a point; thence North 0 degrees 05 minutes 56 seconds East a distance of 100.00 feet to a point; thence North 89 degrees 54 minutes 04 seconds West a distance of 10.00 feet to a point; thence North 0 degrees 05 minutes 56 seconds East a distance of 139.83 feet to a point on the centerline of an existing drainage ditch; thence North 74 degrees 20 minutes 30 seconds East a distance of 46.29 feet, along the existing centerline of said drainage ditch, to a point the east line of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 27; thence South 0 degrees 20 minutes 29 seconds West a distance of 252.41 feet, along the east line of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 27, to the Point of Beginning.
