It is the policy of the County of Macon to support the Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988 and to implement a Fair Housing Program to ensure equal opportunity in housing for all persons regardless of race, color, religion, sex, disability (physical and mental), familial status (1. Children, and 2. Actual or perceived sexual orientation, gender identity or marital status or its members), or national origin.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Macon County Board, THAT WITHIN THE RESOURCES AVAILABLE TO Macon County through city, county, state, federal and community volunteer sources, the County will assist all persons who feel they have been discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, disability (physical and mental), familial status (children) or national origin in the process of filing a complaint with the Illinois Department of Human Rights or the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, that they may seek equity under federal and state laws.
