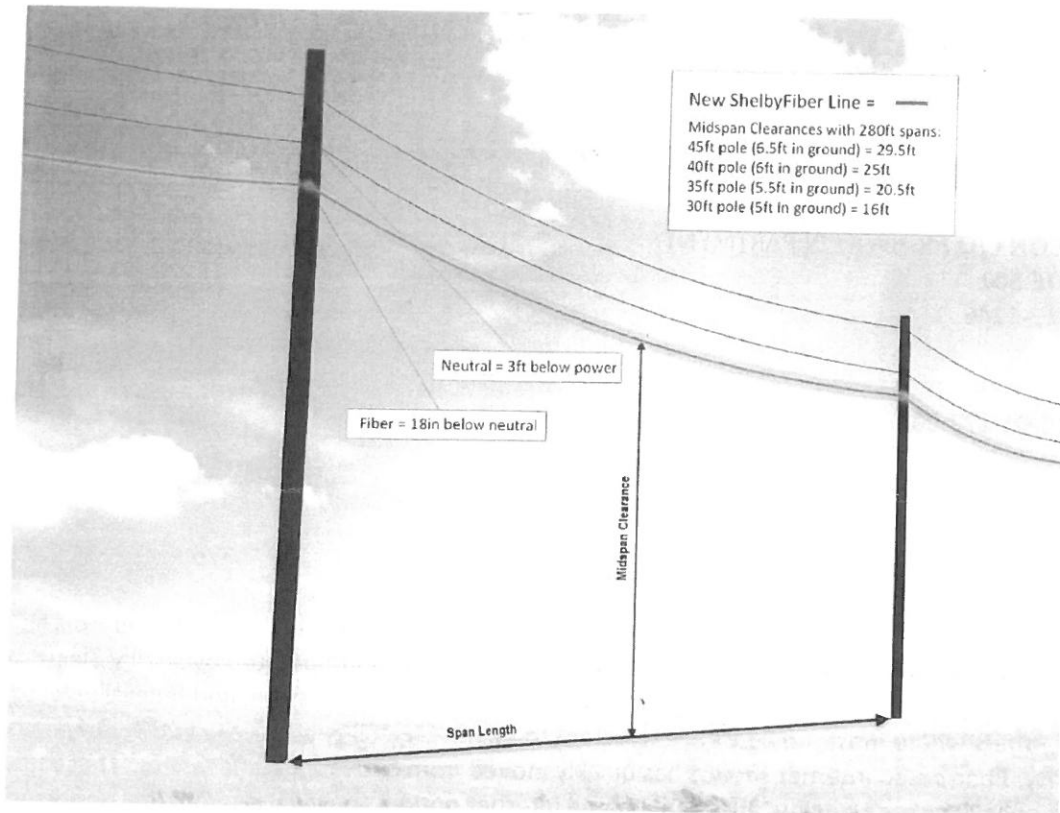

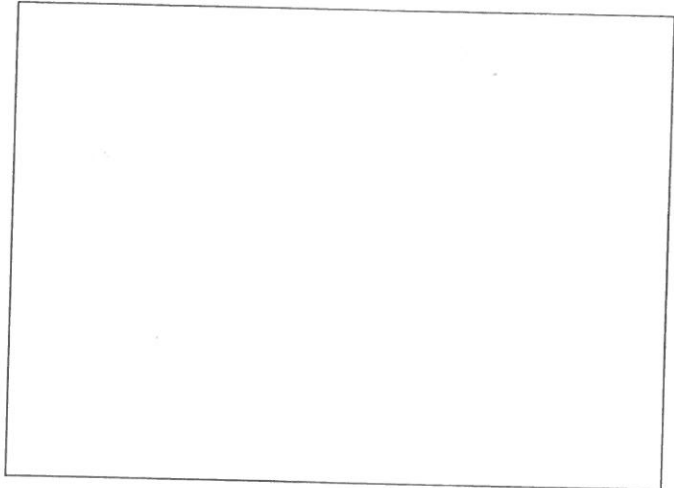
## Typical Single-phase Construction with Fiber

BE IT KNOWN that the Grantor, the County of Macon, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby sell, convey, grant, and warrant to SHELBY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, an Illinois not-for-profit corporation, and to its successors and assigns (hereinafter "Grantee"), a Permanent Right of Way Easement & Temporary Construction Easement for the purpose of a permanent electric distribution and fiber optic telecommunication system easement. When the utility line follows the existing public right-of-way, said easement shall extend twenty (20) feet in width from the edge of the right-of-way; in all other instances, said easement shall be as specifically defined in the attached **Exhibit A**.

Said easement shall specifically include the right to construct, reconstruct, place, erect, install, alter, repair, patrol, rebuild, and thereafter use, operate, and maintain an overhead electrical distribution system and a fiber optic telecommunication system and all appurtenances, equipment, and facilities thereto, over, on, and/or across said parcel, and to cut and trim trees and shrubbery to the extent necessary in the discretion of Grantee, to keep them clear of said electric and fiber optic lines or system and to cut down from time to time all dead, weak, leaning, or dangerous trees that are tall enough to strike wires or otherwise damage the electric and/or fiber optic lines or system located upon said parcel situated in the County of Macon, State of Illinois, described as follows:

See attached **Exhibit A** for property legal description(s) and location of proposed facilities.

The electric distribution and fiber optic telecommunication system facilities may be overhead or at ground level, and may consist of poles, wires, conduit, conductor, guys, transformers, anchors, telecommunications equipment, fiber optic cable, and any other related equipment and facilities necessary in the sole discretion of the Grantee.

The Grantee agrees that it shall use good faith efforts, time, and costs such as a prudent person would use, expend, or incur, in similar circumstances to minimize impact on Grantor's property, including avoidance when practicable of placing guy wires, anchors, or other facilities in crop or hay land, and including communicating with the Grantor regarding the location for installation.

With the exception of circumstances in which emergency repairs are necessary to the electric distribution or fiber optic telecommunication systems, construction, maintenance, and repair activities provided for herein, shall not occur during wet conditions which prevent normal farming operations, such as plowing, discing, planting, or harvesting.

This easement shall grant to SHELBY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE the right to construct, operate, and maintain, consistent with standard utility practices, an electric distribution system and a fiber optic telecommunication system on the above described lands and/or in or upon all streets, roads or highways abutting said lands.

It is understood and agreed that this easement and right of way shall give and convey to the Grantee, the perpetual right and privilege to enter and exit the lands above described for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, and repairing the above described electric and fiber optic telecommunication systems, as well as the perpetual right to transmit telecommunications including but not limited to fiber optic, voice, data, metering, and video signals for both private utility use and commercial use. Grantee agrees that it shall use good faith efforts such as a prudent person would use in similar circumstances, to reach mutually acceptable entrance and exit locations to access the easement so as to minimize impact to the surrounding land.

For the same consideration as hereinabove described, the Grantor herein does hereby sell, convey, grant, and warrant to SHELBY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, a Temporary Construction Easement over and across the same property described hereinabove in a width necessary to make the initial construction of the electric utility and fiber optic telecommunication systems. It also gives the Grantee the right to maintain, consistent with standard utility practice, those systems.

The undersigned agrees that all poles, wires, conduit, conductor, guys, transformers, anchors, telecommunications equipment, fiber optic cable, and other facilities, including any service entrance equipment installed on or above ground on the above-described lands shall remain the property of the Grantee, removable at the option of the Grantee, upon termination of service to or on said lands.

While efforts will be made to minimize the risk of any property damage, including but not limited to crop damage, the Grantee covenants that following any work conducted pursuant to the Temporary Construction Easement or Right of Way Easement for electric distribution and/or fiber optic telecommunication systems, that it will work with those landowners who experience damage to return the surface of the land to as near as original condition as possible or to determine appropriate compensation for the loss. In this regard, the Grantee agrees that it shall use good faith efforts, time, and costs such as a prudent person would use, expend, or incur, in similar circumstances to ensure that any damage to the Grantor's property is mitigated and repaired. With regard to crop damage, the process for determining value of the loss will include consideration for the type of crop being grown, current market price, average yield per acre, and the measurement of the impacted area. Compensation for any crop damage will generally be paid within the year that the damage occurs.

It is further understood that this instrument constitutes the entire agreement between the Grantor and Grantee. This grant of easement and all other provisions herein described shall constitute a covenant running with the land for the benefit of SHELBY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE and its successors and assigns.

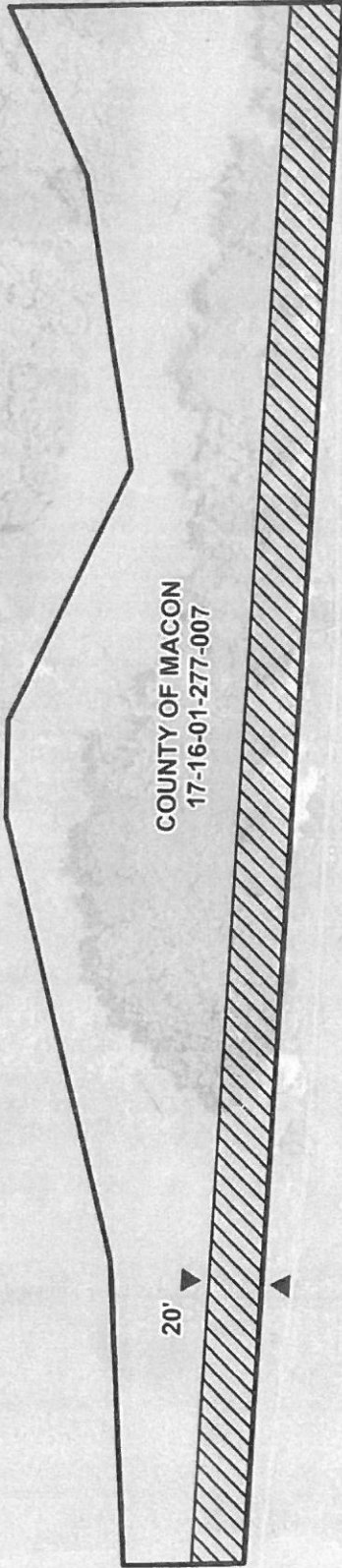

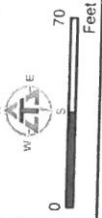
