Committee approval of Office Cleaning Contract.

Bruce Bird explained that we had two bidders for the cleaning contract. The first is Laura and Amanda's Commercial & Home Cleaning, the second is The Perfect Touch Cleaning. Both bidders references came back good. Amanda's Commercial & Home Cleaning came in the day of the bid did a tour of the building and filled out their paperwork. Their bid came in at \$1,000 monthly. The second bidder, we have a past relationship with and they always did a great job. The only issue we had was that the billing was done hourly and got a little out of control. County Engineer's Report:

CH 30 (Elwin Rd): The contractors finished the Microsurfacing work today, next week the stripers will come in and complete that job. Once it is complete it will be like a race track out there.

CH 41 (Wyckles Rd): The contractor has a few items left to complete including signs, seeding, and some asphalt work. This section is set be open around October 1, 2014.

CH 21 (Kenney Blacktop): The contractors on this job have made some good progress. The piling has been driven and they are now working on getting the north abutment poured.

CH 29 (Boody Rd): This bridge is set to start construction around October 1, 2014.

Spacemark Project: We have a meeting scheduled tomorrow, with the contractor, to discuss the progress schedule on this project. A gas line has been discovered in the right-of-way that will more than likely have to be moved. The portion of this closer to Route 51 will not start until next year.

Cold In Place Recycling Project (CH 38 from Maroa east over to CH 25): The cold in place recycling is complete and next week we will move on to the chip sealing and Microsurfacing of this roadway.

Maintenance Crews: Have been making patch, mowing, and doing some culvert work. We did get our salt order in; we were not the first though. Champaign County beat us to the punch.

Mark Wicklund briefly touched on some information he brought in from TRIP.
